Everyone can & should carry it - the Good Samaritan law protects all people who administer it.

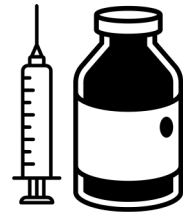
## When recommending naloxone to people, consider: Formulations, availability, anonymity, & cost.

### Formulations

Only higher dose IN & IM formulations are Rx.  
4 & 3 mg IN are OTC.



IN: OTC & Rx  
3-4 mg & 8 mg



Naloxone

IM: Rx only  
0.4 mg, 5 mg

### Availability

@Pharmacy -  
Rx & OTC  
@Shelves -  
OTC Anonymity

- People can obtain unlabeled IN & IM naloxone anonymously through OTC purchase or from community programs.
- The standing order or an Rx for naloxone will generate a pharmacy record & labeled product dispensed from the pharmacy w/counseling.

### Costs

-\$50 OTC  
-\$0-50 Rx

- Standing order & prescribed IN and IM naloxone may be covered by insurance with a copay.
- Copays can be paid using health savings/flexible spending accounts. These accounts can also be used to cover the OTC naloxone cost (no sales tax). Community naloxone is FREE.
